Foreign policy of the Republic of Lostisland and its diplomatic relationship with other states

Appendix to the Decree of the Captains Regent DEC CAR 02/11/02/12

1. General provisions

- 1.1. This document is regulating the foreign policy of the Republic of Lostisland and its diplomatic relations with other states.
- 1.2. This document is to be distributed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Lostisland and affiliated to it institutions.
- 1.3. This document is retroactive and attributes to all current and future diplomatic relationships of the Republic of Lostisland.

2. Terms

- 2.1. For this document are used the following terms:
 - a) nation – a sovereign entity which is a member of the UN or of the UNPO or is recognized by one or more members of the UN;
 - b) micronation – an entity which pretends to be a sovereign but is not a member of the UN or of the UNPO or is not recognized by one or more members of the UN, but meets the requirements of the Montevideo Convention;
 - c) diplomatic relationship – a stage in the foreign policy of the Republic of Lostisland which starts with the signing of the Treaty of Mutual Recognition with other state;

3. Types of diplomatic relationship

- 3.1. The Republic of Lostisland differs two types of diplomatic relationship:
 - a) National – diplomatic relationship between Lostisland and an entity which meets the requirements of p. 2.1. a) of this document;

- b) Micronational – diplomatic relationship between Lostisland and an entity which doesn't meet the requirements of 2.1. a), but meets the requirements of p. 2.1. b).

4. Provisions of diplomatic relationship

4.1. National diplomatic relationship includes:

- a) recognition of the territorial claims;
- b) recognition of the documents;
- c) recognition of any other items not included in p. 4.1. a) and b).

4.2. Micronational diplomatic relationship includes:

- a) see p. 4.1. b)

Micronational diplomatic relationship may not include p. 4.1. a) and p. 4.1. c), unless otherwise is stated in the Treaty of mutual recognition and Establishment of diplomatic relations.

5. Impossibility of diplomatic relationship

5.1. Independently from p. 3.1., the Republic of Lostisland is not establishing diplomatic relations with entities in which are present

- a) Nazism and/or fascism;
- b) violation of human rights which comes from the government;
- c) actions, aimed against the global peace and safety of the humanity.

6. Authority of establishment

6.1. The authority of establishment of diplomatic relations belongs to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs with further appointment by the Captains Regent, or to the Captains Regent solely.
